

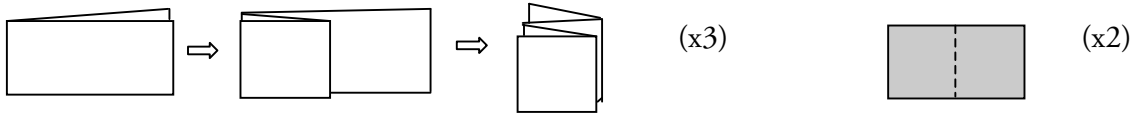
# Mini Board Book

## You will need:

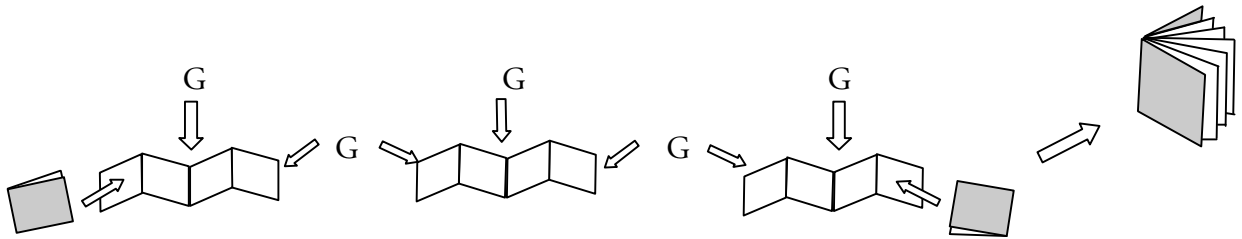
3 strips white drawing paper (4" x 16") grain short  
 2 inner covers (4" x 8") grain short (65 lb. colored cardstock)  
 1 outer cover (4" x 8.5") grain short (white cardstock, tag, or 140 lb. watercolor paper)  
 double-stick tape (3-M #415)  
 glue stick or white glue  
 scoring tool (metal knitting needle) and ruler  
 bone folder

## To Assemble:

Fold and crease 3 accordion strips into 4 panels each. Then fold and crease 2 inner covers.



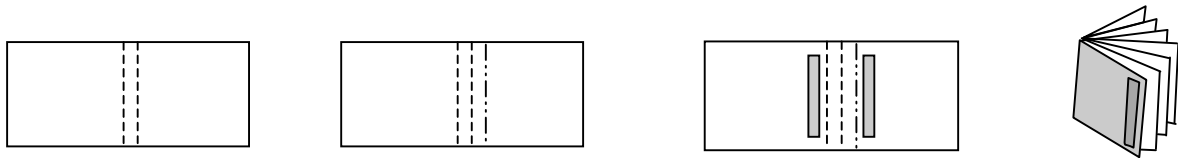
Glue together the center two pages of each strip. Attach accordions together with glue on reverse. Then attach clamshell covers on final segment on each end. This becomes a colored end-sheet.



**OUTER COVER:** Outer cover will have total of 3 fold lines, 1/4" apart.

First, create 1/4" double spine in the center. Then score one extra line, 1/4" from right spine fold. This extra fold goes back, in the reverse direction, and will be on the back cover.

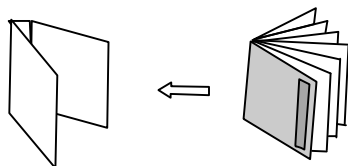
Add two strips of double-stick tape on outer cover, close to scored spine folds. Add 2 more tapes on each outer fore edge of each inner cover. Peel off spine tapes first, and insert booklet into outer cover. Then peel fore edge tapes and press. (Optional: use white glue instead of tape.)



Fold double-spine

Add 3<sup>rd</sup> fold

Double-stick tape on outer and inner



Insert book into outer-cover
